FAMILY ACTIVITIES

NEIGHBOURHOOD MAP

MATERIALS:

- Bristol board
- Markers
- Pencils
- Camera

DIRECTIONS:

- Invite the whole family to go for a walk. Take a camera with you.
- Notice interesting objects and landmarks on your way, and take pictures of them.
- Remember the names of the streets that you pass.
- At home, sit together and draw a map of the neighbourhood.
- Assign one family member to draw your house.
- Invite everyone to add the landmarks and objects that you noticed on your walk. Use the photographs as a reference.
- Hang the map of your neighbourhood on the wall. You can continue adding details to the map later.

FAMILY FUN BASKET

MATERIALS:

- Basket
- Pieces of paper
- Pencil

DIRECTIONS:

- Brainstorm some "no-prep" activity ideas for your family and write each
 one on a separate piece of paper. For example, "Hug someone and say I
 love you", "Imitate one of your family members and let others guess who
 they are", etc.
- Fold the pieces of paper and put them in a basket.
- Gather your family and take turns drawing from the basket and acting out what the paper says.
- Keep adding different activities to adopt to the family gathering.
- Continue this activity every year as a special family tradition on Family Day.

MATERIALS:

- Pens or coloured pencils
- Paper
- Envelopes

DIRECTIONS:

- Invite family members to sit down together.
- Ask each person to write a loving note or a greeting card to each member

- List one or two special qualities for each person and let them know they are special to you.
- Encourage younger children to draw special pictures for each family member.
- Place the notes into envelopes and deliver them to family.
